For the next few weeks Park Avenue will be buzzing with activity. Preparations for the annual Park Avenue Tree Lighting have begun! The trees are always delivered on Veterans Day and last Monday night this truck - carrying over 100 fir trees - arrived in New York City. As it made its way up the avenue, trees were unloaded on to each of the malls between 54th and 96th Streets. In the coming weeks, the trees will be installed in the end beds and strung with lights to create a sparkling memorial to honor all of the men and women who lost their lives defending our country. The tradition of lighting trees on Park Avenue began in 1945 and has continued each year because of the support The Fund for Park Avenue receives from the community. Thank you for helping make this happen!

The trees will be lit on Sunday, December 8th following a ceremony outside the Brick Presbyterian Church (Park Avenue at 91st Street) that begins at 6:30 p.m.
